No	320 responses	33.02%


Q2: On average how often would you usually purchase takeaway alcohol?

Infrequently (every 2-4 weeks)	21.67%	210
Frequently (every 1-2 weeks)	39.94%	387
Very frequently (more than once per week)	16.31%	158

Q3: If/when you purchase takeaway alcohol, which of the following statements describes you:-

I do not purchase alcohol.	4.02%	39

Other	1.14%	11




Q5: I believe that having less restrictions on take-away alcohol within the City of Karratha than other north-west towns will result in an increase in crime and anti-social behaviour over time


Q6: I believe that you SHOULD NOT be able to buy takeaway alcohol in the City of Karratha before 11.00am


Q7: I believe that you SHOULD NOT be able to buy takeaway alcohol in the City of Karratha after 8pm.


Q8: I believe that you SHOULD NOT be able to buy takeaway alcohol from liquor stores on Sundays


Q9: I believe that you SHOULD NOT be able to buy wine/spirits in containers greater than 2 litres in volume.


Q10: I believe that you SHOULD NOT be able to purchase fortified wine in containers greater than one litre.


Q11: I believe that you SHOULD NOT be able to purchase beer in glass bottles of 750ml or more.




