My name is Aimee Troy of 18 Andover Way Karratha and I object to the proposed rate increases. With the following points of consideration:

- House value decrease
- My wages have decreased due to CPI
- A number of new assets which should have had the maintenance and operation costs projected and therefore if they couldn't be afford then we shouldn't have got them.
- Purchase of the quarter was this really necessary with the then increase in rates being pushed onto rate payers.

Prioritise the COK spend, make the necessary hard-line changes in order to get the COK spend in order, not lump this onto the rate payers. Prioritise the maintenance and capital spending in line with current rates.

And example I see a ute driving around town with sometimes up to 3-4 people picking up rubbish or driving around the streets looking for rubbish.. Is this really necessary, why not go back and make sporting clubs work for their sponsorship and support "bags for bucks program", or look at a tidy town committee similar to Wickham in which the community feel passionate about doing these kinds of jobs themselves...
